What might happen next? Which clues helped you to make this prediction? Are there clues in any pictures? What information from your own life helped you make your prediction?

Do you have any questions about what you have read? Do you have any questions about a character or event? What would you like to know more about? How did this text make you feel? Why?

Are there any words or phrases that you are unsure about? What could you do to help you understand (clarify) the meaning of the word or phrase?

(You could reread around it; read on; find parts of the word you know; look in a dictionary; discuss with a friend/family member)

i≣ Summarise i≣

Can you retell what you have read in your own words? What are the most important events or ideas in this text? What order did the events happen in? If you were to write a review of this text, what would you say? What is the main point of this text? Who are the main characters? Which key words would you choose to help you summarise this text/what you have read?
